ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Document incident/ accident reports when needed (IMR)
- Assist in maintaining the After School Program clean and orderly
- May consult with parents concerning member issues.
- Attend monthly ASP meetings
- Drive Club van. (Optional-see van driver requirements)
- Participate in Club events.
- Complete additional training hours as required by the Department of Early Education & Care
- Additional responsibilities as determined by supervisor

REQUIRED EXPERIENCE:

A group leader shall be at least 18 years of age and meet one of the following requirements:

1. Have a minimum of a Bachelor's Degree or Associates Degree; and have three months of experience working with school age children: or

2. Have a high school diploma of equivalent: and have six months experience working with school age children including three months supervised experience at a school age child care program

SKILLS/KNOWLEDGE

- Strong communication skills, both verbal and written.
- Ability to maintain calm and organized in stressful situations
- Group leadership skills, including an understanding of group dynamics.
- Ability to maintain a high, positive energy level.
