The Waltham Boys & Girls Club's Licensed Afterschool Program (ASP) is structured to develop and implement programs and activities that prepare youth for success. This program is offered to youth ages **5* – 12.**

*All 5 year olds must be enrolled in kindergarten.

Transportation to the club is available to participants who attend Waltham schools. Transportation is limited on a first come, first serve basis

How to Register

To enroll please submit a completed ASP and Club Membership Application, along with your child's most recent physical and immunization history. All applicants must partake in a mandatory parent orientation with the ASP Director prior to enrolling. Orientations will not be scheduled until all required documentations are turned in.

2019-2020 ASP Enrollment

Priority enrollment for current members begins June 3, 2019 and runs through June 31, 2019. All required documentation must be turned in in order to be considered fully enrolled. Open enrollment for new members begins July 1, 2019. All new members must participate in a New Parent Orientation.

Yearly enrollment is ongoing based on space and availability. Applications available at the Front Desk and online.
