The successful candidate will be both an effective leader of programming AND a key member of the Waltham Boys & Girls Club staff. Our ideal team member position plans, develops and oversees program implementation in 5 core areas: Education & Career Development; Sports, Fitness & Recreation; The Arts; Health & Life Skills; and Character & Leadership Development. Mentoring the coordinators who oversee these program areas is an essential part of the role. We need a hands on leader that brings talent, creativity, hard work and a sense of humor to the club.

Job Summary

Some of the responsibilities include hands on coverage in program areas, guiding youth to make good choices, as well as overseeing building, staff, closing procedures, and overall Club-wide supervision. S/he will guide coordinators to innovate new programming and strengthen existing programs. Administrative tasks include budgetary oversight, proper record keeping and reporting, performance reviews, scheduling, and Club promotion through various marketing strategies.

- Group leadership skills, including an understanding of group dynamics.
- Demonstrated organizational, staff and project management abilities.
- Must have a valid driver's license. Mandatory 7D License, CPR and First Aid Certifications.
- Experience with the following a plus: Sports & Recreation, Licensed Camp Program, Aquatics Programs, Music Education and bi-lingual (Spanish English speaking).
