While camp will look and feel a bit different this summer, the Waltham Boys & Girls Club is committed to ensuring that our staff will create the same memorable experience for campers. We have a safety plan that will follow the Department of Public Health's (DPH) Camp Safety Guidelines for social distancing, reduced cohorts, face coverings, hand washing, and disinfecting - similar to the successful plan we have been utilizing all school year with our School Day Learning Center. *

- Campers will be required to fill out a daily health attestation to prevent potential illness from coming to camp
- Face masks will be worn at all times when not eating/drinking or during mask breaks
- Groups will stay in their cohorts and will only mix with other groups in accordance with CDC guidelines
- Additional handwashing breaks will be integrated throughout the camp day
- Frequent disinfecting and cleaning will occur
- Drop-off and pick-up procedures will limit exposure between families
- Most sessions are two-weeks long to reduce exposure

Waltham Boys & Girls Club Food Program: Breakfast, afternoon snack and lunch are available for each camper. Complete summer meal menus will be available on our website prior to summer camp.

- Breakfast is served each morning between 8:00 AM – 8:30 AM and includes cereal, milk, and 100% juice
- Lunch is served every day between 12:00 PM – 12:45 PM and adheres to the USDA nutrition guidelines
- Afternoon snack is served at 3:00 PM

Scholarship Information: Application Deadline is May 3rd

These are awarded based on financial need. Applications are available at the Club or on the website. Scholarship and voucher information must be submitted to the Club. Scholarship recipients will be notified of their award by May 21st

Summer camp staff are certified in CPR/First Aid and Child Abuse Prevention. Our camp program complies with regulations of the MA Dept. of Public Health and is licensed by the Waltham Board of Health.
