Crisis Food Program

Since schools closed due to COVID-19 on March 13th, 2020, the Waltham Boys & Girls Club has served over 78,000 "graband-go" meals for the young people who need them most across Waltham.

School-Day Learning Center

The Waltham Boys & Girls Club implemented a new model to meet the unique challenges faced by youth engaging in virtual education. This inperson academic support program features technical assistance for students to connect with their teachers virtually, academic support for independent learning, social and emotional support, and physical activity breaks.

SILENT AUCTION BIDDING INSTRUCTIONS

The Silent Auction will be open for bidding on Sunday, April 25th and will close during the event on Thursday, April 29th.

- Visit www.walthambgc.org/virtualgala
- You must be logged-in to bid. If you're not currently logged in, a "Register to Bid" button will appear when you attempt to place your first bid.
- Scroll down to the "Silent Auction" tab.
- All silent auction items will be shown. Filter by category, type, or search for a specific item.
 - Click on an auction item's photo to see enlarged and additional photos.
- Hover over an item and click "Bid" to place a bid. The amount shown is the minimum amount for the next bid. Clicking the plus sign allows you to increase the bid amount.
- After placing a bid, you'll have the option to set a Max Bid. This allows the system to automatically bid for you incrementally up to your highest specified amount. You will only be charged the winning bid if it is lower than your set max.
- A trophy icon will appear on lots where you are the current highest bidder. If you are outbid, you will receive a text notification.
